The cardinal objective of said prehearing conference will be:

- (1) to hear and consider all issues relating to the petitions filed by the City of Cleveland in the above-captioned proceedings, and any other petitions to intervene in the Perry antitrust proceedings;
- (2) to hear and consider all issues relating to whether the three captioned proceedings, above, should be consolidated; and
- (3) to receive any other additional information that may be relevant to this proceeding as noted by the Commission on page 3 of its Memorandum and Order.



- (1) the status of negotiations referred to by the Commission, and prospect of settlement;



IT IS SO ORDERED.


