REQUEST OF AEC REGULATORY STAFF FOR AN ADDITIONAL
SIXTY DAYS IN WHICH TO ANSWER THE CITY OF
CLEVELAND, OHIO'S PETITION TO INTERVENE AND
REQUEST FOR AN ANTITRUST HEARING

On November 5, 1971, the staff requested a thirty-day extension of time for filing an answer to the City of Cleveland, Ohio's petition for leave to intervene and request for an antitrust hearing in the captioned proceeding. We have found, however, that this period was insufficient for formulating the regulatory staff's position in the need for an antitrust hearing in the matter. Accordingly, it is requested that the staff be granted an additional sixty days in which to answer the petition of application to intervene.

Counsel for the City of Cleveland, Ohio, and the applicant do not object to the requested extension of time.
