REQUEST OF AEC REGULATORY STAFF FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO
ANSWER PETITION TO INTERVENE OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND, OHIO

Pursuant to 10 CFR §2.711, the staff requests an additional extension of time of thirty days for filing an answer to the City of Cleveland's petition for leave to intervene and request for an antitrust hearing in the captioned proceeding.

In support of its request, the staff submits the following:

1. Applicant Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company's (CEI) position regarding a major contention of petitioner depends in part on the latter's payment of undisputed amounts now owing to CEI for past services. Such payment is expected to be tendered within the next several weeks. Thereafter, the staff will be in a better position to evaluate the contentions of the parties.
2. The requested extension of time will not delay the licensing process.
3. Counsel for the applicants and the City of Cleveland, Ohio, do not object to the requested extension of time.
