



exceeding fifteen pages in length may be filed on or before June 20, 1977.

Exceptions 4, 5 and 6 are not to be briefed. Exception 4 is the subject of an independent appeal taken by the City which is now pending before this Board. Exception 5 deals with a question already resolved by us in ALAB-290, 2 NRC 401, and ALAB-300, 2 NRC 752 (1975). Exception 6 is not addressed to the result reached by the Licensing Board; thus, the ruling complained of therein may not be brought to us by way of an appeal. See Consumers Power Co. (Midland Plant, Units 1 and 2), ALAB-282, 2 NRC 9, fn. 1 and accompanying text (1975).


All briefs of the City - Blue
