MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 24, 1977 when Applicants moved without opposition for a ten day extension of time within which to file Applicants' Appeal Brief, they indicated that they would not object to any similar extension that might be requested by parties answering said Brief. It is with this in mind that the NRC Staff moves this Appeal Board for a twenty-one day extension of time within which to file Briefs in opposition to Applicants' Brief. This adjustment to the schedule is necessitated by: (i) the fact that the Staff has moved the location of its offices during the briefing period thereby severly limiting access to the record below for approximately one week; (ii) the form of presentation of arguments in the Brief advanced by the other side and their relationship to the six-hundred fortythree exceptions previously filed; and (iii) the nature and complexity of the issues involved in this proceeding. In so moving, Staff notes that this extension will not adversely impact on the construction or operation of any of the captioned nuclear units. Counsel for the City of Cleveland has advised that it does not oppose this motion.

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WHEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that the time within which to file Briefs in Opposition to Applicants' or the City's Exceptions be extended to and including June 30, 1977, with reply briefs due July 21, 1977.
