Dear Ms. Kipnis:

I am pleased to respond to your latter of March 12, 1975, in which you expressed an interest in nuclear power plants being built near the Lake Erie region of Ohio.

In response to your request for information regarding the licensing procedures for nuclear power plants, I am enclosing a pamphlet and a booklet entitled, "Licensing of Muclear Power Reactors" and "Study of the Reactor Licensing Process", which describe the licensing process.

Also, your letter requests information on Davis-Besse, Perry and Erie Nuclear Power Plants. A summary of this information is given below: however, a complete record of the licensing process on these plants is available for public inspection in the Local Public Document Rooms and at the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 M Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

Toledo Edison Company's Davis-Eesse Muclear Power Station. Units 1. 2 and 3 are located in Ottawa County, Ohio. Davis-Besse Unit 1 is in the review process for an operating license. A construction per it (CPFF-30) was issued on March 24, 1971. By Memorandum and Order dated Lovember 1, 1973, the Board dismissed the proceeding related to the operating license hearing. Davis-Besse Units 2 and 3 are presently under raview by the PRC staff for construction permits. A hearing will be held, but at the present, no date has been set for the hearing. The modification for is presently scheduled for 1903 and 1935. The hearing for twis-Besse Units 1. 2 and 3 is the Ha Rupp Public Library, 310 Thrison Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452.

The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company's (CEI) Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2 are located 35 miles northeast of Cleveland on Lake Erie in Lake County, Ohio. The application for construction permits is now under review. A Limited Work Authorization (LWA) authorizing certain site preparation work was issued to CEI on October 21, 1974. An Order to Show Cause, issued on January 20, 1975, has temporarily suspended all work activities authorized by the LWA of October 21, 1974. At the present, there is no date set for a safety hearing. The local PDR for Perry Units 1 and 2 is the Perry Public Library, 3753 Main Street, Perry, Ohio 44081.

The Ohio Edison Company's Erie Power Station, Units 1 and 2 are at present proposing to construct a two unit nuclear power plant located a few miles from Lake Erie near Berlin Heights and approximately nine miles northeast of Sandusky, Ohio. Ohio Edison Company plans to submit their early site information some time this fall. At the present, no local PDR has been set up for this facility.

I hope that this letter with its enclosures is responsive to your concerns and provides you with the information you require regarding the nuclear power plants you mentioned.
