## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

By letter dated April 21, 1971, the Coalition for Safe Nuclear Power, an intervenor in the captioned reactor licensing proceeding, filed a motion with the Commission for "an order staying the effective date of the construction permit issued to the applicant[s] until such time as a final judicial determination has been made upon the exceptions filed herein on behalf of said Intervenor". The referenced construction permit, for a pressurized water nuclear power reactor, was issued to the applicants pursuant to an initial decision handed down on March 23, 1971, by the presiding Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (36 F. R. 5930, March 31, 1971).

The notice of hearing in this proceeding (35 F. R. 16999,
November 4, 1970) stated that the Commission had delegated to the
Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board the authority and the review
function which would otherwise be exercised and performed by the
Commission. We are, accordingly, referring the subject motion to
the Appeal Board for appropriate determination.

It is so ORDERED.
