Dear Mr. Stanton:

This is in response to your letter to Chairman Seaborg dated April 5, 1971, which enclosed a letter from Mrs. Belinda Fiorelli concerning the proposed Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant near Port Clinton, Ohio.

In response to a number of inquiries on the Davis-Besse plant, we have prepared the enclosed summary which describes the proceedings concerned with the licensing of the plant, and the controls that the AEC will have over the plant during its lifetime.

In addition, Mrs. Fiorelli may be interested in the enclosed detailed statement on the environmental considerations associated with the construction of the Davis-Besse plant, which was prepared by the AEC regulatory staff as required by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969.

I am also enclosing a copy of Dr. Seaborg's comments on nuclear power presented recently at a National Press Club luncheon in Washington, D.C.
