Dear Mr. Ashley:

This is in reply to your letter dated January 22, 1971, which enclosed a letter from Mr. Clifford D. Gesinger concerning the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station.

In his letter, Mr. Gesinger expresses concern that homes will be in an almost cloud of steam due to the operation of the Davis-Besse cooling towers. The Toledo Edison Company has stated that studies of cooling tower installation indicated that under no situation would the water vapor plume discharge from the cooling tower produce a general cloud cover or general ground level fogging condition. The company stated further that, under very unusual conditions, the moisture plume could approach ground level or lake level, but the probability of these occurrences is very small. A detailed discussion of the cooling tower system and its atmospheric effects is included in the enclosed Detailed Statement on the Environmental Considerations related to the Davis-Besse plant.

In response to a number of inquiries on the proposed plant, we have prepared a summary which describes the proceedings concerned with the licensing the plant, and the controls that the AEC will have over the plant during its lifetime. I am enclosing a copy of the summary for Mr. Gesinger's information.
