Gentlemen:

On October 21, 1971, the above captioned matter was remanded from the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia to the Commission for NEPA review, "including the consideration of suspension of the construction permit" issued to Toledo Edison and CEI for the Davis-Besse plant. That review is now in progress under Appendix D of 10 CFR, Part 50, §E.

As counsel for intervenors Coalition and LIFE, I am advising the Commission that we wish to present opposing comments upon the statement submitted to the Commission by the applicants as to why construction should not be halted during NEPA review.
