

OPERATING LICENSE

Notice is hereby given that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 2 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-54 issued to Sacramento Municipal Utility District which revised Technical Specifications for operation of the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 1, located in Sacramento County, California. The amendment becomes effective 30 days after the date of issuance.

The amendment revises the administrative control section of the Technical Specifications for the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 1.

The applications for the amendment comply with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Lnergy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment. Prior public notice of this amendment is not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.
