This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter to the Atomic Energy Commission dated October 17, 1968.

As Mr. Bond explained in his September 10, 1968 letter to you, the AEC's regulatory authority is limited to matters of radiological health and safety and the common defense and security. Because we have no authority with respect to a license applicant's hiring practices, we are referring your recent letter, a copy of your August 29, 1968 letter, and a copy of Mr. Bond's letter to you to the Office of Federal Contract Compliance (EEO) for whatever assistance they may be able to provide.
