Dear John:

Following our review of an application by Sacramento Municipal Utilities District, a construction permit was granted on October 11, 1968, to construct the Rancho Seco Generating Station Unit 1. Since then, Sacramento Municipal Utilities District has submitted Supplement No. 1, dated December 15, 1968, and Supplement No. 2, dated July 8, 1969, which made certain design changes. I am sending you a copy of the most recent one, Supplement No. 2. The initial application and Preliminary Safety Analysis Report with amendments thereto was sent to Gene Blanc at the time we reviewed the application for a construction permit. I assume these were transferred to your office, but if you do not have them and would like a set, I will be glad to forward them to you.

I am also enclosing a copy of Amendment No. 4, dated July 10, 1969, to the application filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company for its nuclear unit 2 at the Diablo Canyon site. That application with amendments was previously sent to you.

the files and that we would only tell me what testing Herron did, not the results of the test, unless I had a release from Bentley. I was not able to get in touch with Mr. Sutcliffe again until July 27, because of the Hearings, Mr. Sutcliffe then advised me that Herron Testing had done testing for backfill material -- rock material. Because of the extreme amount of work involved in preparing for the hearing, it was impossible for me to obtain this information sooner, particularly in view of the fact that I was advised by Mr. Roe that Herron Testing was in Pennsylvania, and the Coalition did not have adequate finances for extensive investigations. In addition to making two trips to the Davis-Besse site for interviews, I also made one trip to the office of Toledo Edison in Toledo, and four trips to Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company's office in Cleveland, attempting to obtain answers to our interrogatories, and during the same period of time I also had to respond to Applicants' Interrogatories and AEC Interrogatories to us.
