Dear Mr. Blanc:

Sacramento Municipal Utility District, Sacramento, California, has filed an application for authorization to construct and operate a pressurized water nuclear reactor on the applicant's site located in the southeast portion of Sacramento County, California.

The proposed nuclear reactor, designated as the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 1, is designed for initial operation at approximately 2452 megawatts (thermal) with a net electrical output of approximately 800 megawatts. Earliest and latest construction completion dates are estimated to be December 1972 and December 1973, respectively.

Four copies of a related notice which has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication is enclosed. Also enclosed is a copy of the application, including Volumes I, II, III, and IV of the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report.
