Sacramento Municipal Utility District, 6201 S Street, Post Office Box 15830, Sacramento, California 95813, pursuant to Section 104(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, has filed an application, dated November 1, 1967, for authorization to construct and operate a pressurized water nuclear reactor on the applicant's approximately 2480-acre site located in the southeast part of Sacramento County, about twenty-five miles southeast of Sacramento, California.

The proposed reactor, designated by the applicant as the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 1, is designed for initial operation at approximately 2452 megawatts (thermal), with a net electrical output of approximately 800 megawatts.
