Re: Discussions and Understandings Between Counsel

Door Roith:

This will be an attempt to reduce to writing various matters discussed by yourself and Mr. Ross with the undersigned during the depositions held at Traverse City, September 10 to September 13, 1973, and by phone on subsequent dates.

- 1. On Monday, I informed you and Mr. Ross that I had completed the Motion to Quash the Daverman subpoena except for the charges which I had not received from Mr. Daverman. I also informed you that I had written letters to your firm and Mr. Daverman requesting the return of all documents furnished by Mr. Daverman to your Grand Rapids counsel, and directing that Mr. Daverman not turn over any additional documents or data pending the Board's ruling on my Motion.
 - 2. On Wednesday, September 12, I furnished you with the charges and empenses incurred by Daverman up to September 7, 1973 and gave additional estimates of time and charges to complete the requestes as agreed upon by Dr. Pace of NERA and Mr. R. J. Daverman. You had requested that I withhold filing the Motion until Consumers Power Company could determine whether or not they would pay Mr. Daverman.
 - 3. Also, on Wednesday, September 12, you met with me to discuss certain discrepancies in the responses by the non-party municipals and the intervenors. You indicated that you had informed Chairman Garfinkel by telephone on that day

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September 18, 1973 - 2 -Keith Watson, Esq. that consideration was being given by Consumers Power Company to the fees of Mr. Daverman and that you had requested me to withhold filing the Motion pending the Company's decision. 4. On Friday, September 14, your office informed Mr. Jablon that the Company would not voluntarily pay Mr. Daverman. Mr. Jablon requested reconsideration. You agreed to reconsider and inform our office of your decision by Monday, September 17. 5. On Monday, September 17, you informed me that although reconsideration had been given, the answer remained that Consumers Power Company would not pay Mr. Daverman, except for copying, unless ordered to do so by the Board. I, in turn, informed you that the Motion to Quash would be filed by September 18. 6. Our discussions concerning discovery remaining with the parties and non-parties involved a typed list for the parties and notes taken by me with respect to the non-parties. I informed you on Monday that you would get copies of my letters to the non-parties containing my instructions concerning the information requested. I will make every effort to obtain the remaining materials as quickly as possible. Keith, I believe the above fairly represents the matters covered.
