

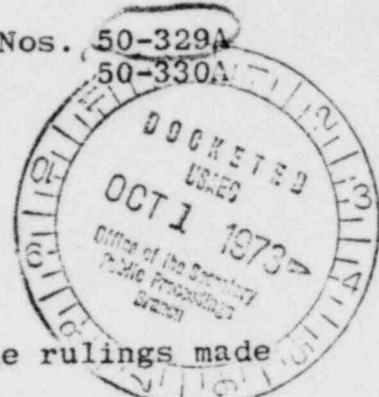

FINAL PREHEARING CONFERENCE



TAKE NOTICE, that in accordance with the rulings made by the instant Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) at the prehearing conference held in this matter on September 7, 1973, the final prehearing conference in the subject proceeding will be held on October 15, 1973, at 10:00 a.m., local time, in Suite 500, Postal Rate Commission, 2000 L Street, N.W., Washington, D. C.

At the final prehearing conference the parties are to exchange those exhibits and prepared testimony intended to be offered into evidence. These exhibits should be numbered prior to the exchange. The parties are also directed to confer prior to the prehearing conference for the purpose of reaching a stipulation as to receipt of the exhibits into evidence, and as to any area of disagreement regarding such exhibits.




Moreover, except for good cause shown, all outstanding discovery by the parties shall be completed by October 15, 1973.


