ORDER OF BOARD DENYING APPLICANT'S MOTION TO STAY AND RECONSIDER ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SEPTEMBER 25, 1973

On October 1, 1973, the Applicant filed a motion requesting that the instant Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) Order of September 25, 1973, concerning documents withheld on grounds other than attorney-client privilege, be stayed and reconsidered by the Board. The Applicant asserts, among other reasons, that the Board's Order is unlawful. After carefully reviewing the Motion and the authorities cited therein, the Board concludes that with two exceptions, the Motion is without merit and is denied.

The Board directs that in providing all other parties with counsel's written instructions, the Applicant's counsel need not include the reasons accompanying such instructions.

In addition, as a result of a telephone conversation between and among the parties and the Board Chairman, it was determined that the Applicant had withheld approximately 800619071.8

1500 documents as not being relevant to the joint request for documents of the Department of Justice, the Regulatory Staff, and the Joint Intervenors. Since the Board, in its Order of September 25, 1973, contemplated a sampling of the withheld documents and not total access, the ruling with respect to such sampling is herewith modified to the extent that the Joint Intervenors will be granted the right to sample 300 documents under terms and conditions set forth in the Board's September 25, 1973 ruling.

During the telephone conversation described above,
Applicant's Counsel orally moved that the instant Board's
ruling be certified to the Appeal Board. The Board Chairman
denied the request.
