Dear Sir:

After review of the document entitled "Draft Detailed Statement of Environmental Considerations" by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission Division of Radiological and Environmental Protection referred to the Proposed Issuance of a construction permit for the Midland Plant, Units 1 & 2 (Packet Nos. 50-329 and 50-330), dated January 7, 1972. The First Central Michigan Economic Development District concurs with the findings contained therein.

The District also reviewed with the local area the concerns of the residents of Midland as to the land use development in Midland County. In reviewing this issue, it was the District's contention that the development of the power plant would not be detrimental to the future development of the City and County. This contention was concurred by the Midland County Planning Director.

The First Central District also strongly urges continued and positive action with regard to the issuance of a construction permit for the Midland Units Nos. 1 and 2. This action is also urged because of the economic advantage of the construction permit will give the area. The First Central District, not only during construction but also during the development of production facilities in the area.

The District's recommendation is approved.
