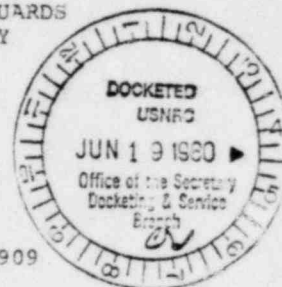

MOTION REQUESTING ORDER THAT PETITIONER
SEACA BE RELIEVED OF THE REQUIREMENT
OF C.F.R. 52.708(d) THAT ONE ORIGINAL AND
20 CONFORMED COPIES OF ALL PLEADINGS BE
FILED WITH THE COMMISSION

Comes now the petitioner The Safe Energy Alliance of Central Alabama (hereinafter "SEACA") and moves this Honorable Commission to relieve it of the requirement of C.F.R. 52.708(d) that one original and 20 conformed copies of all pleadings be filed with the Commission. As grounds therefore, the petitioner shows unto the Commission the following:

1. SEACA is a non-profit corporation with very limited resources and cannot afford the expense and burden of reproducing 20 additional copies of all pleadings sent to the Commission, especially when so many other copies of all pleadings must be mailed.

2. The petitioner's attorney Julian McPhillips has conferred by telephone with U.S. Nuc. Reg. Commission attorney Sherwin Turk about this matter and Mr. Turk suggested this motion as the proper way to proceed.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the petitioner prays that this Honorable Commission will relieve it of the requirement of C.F.R. 52.708(d) that 20 copies of all pleadings be filed with the Commission and instead suffice it that petitioner need file only one original of all pleadings with the Commission.


