This is in reply to your letter dated June 12, 1980, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, information on how Three Mile Island is about to release Krypton gas into the atmosphere, and on what date and how much over the allowable limits the radioactive gas is.

In response to your request, the documents listed in Appendix A are enclosed.

We have been informed by the NRC technical staff that the information contained in documents one and two of Appendix A should answer the questions you have on the release of Krypton gas from TMI-2. The staff also advised us that it has accumulated approximately thirty-six inches of documents as working papers on this subject.

As you may already know, the TMI-2 atmospheric venting operation began on June 28, 1980, and it is proceeding according to the publicly announced plans.
