Dear Mr. Solberg:

PNL has continued programmatic work on the NRC project entitled "Decontamination as a Precursor to Decommissioning." June 1980 activities were:

- J. R. Divine stopped at the ORNL Ecological Sciencies Information Center (ESIC) on the way to a meeting with Frank Witt, NRC. Report format was discussed with C. Fore of that organization. Divine learned that ESIC intends to publish a comprehensive D&D literature review in July; we will take advantage of their publications when our report is prepared and issued.
- An internal rough draft of the outline of the state-of-the-art literature report has been prepared and is being circulated at PNL for comments. Transmittal to NRC is expected by mid-July.
- D. E. Robertson, PNL, reports that he plans to be at Pathfinder Reactor in the period July 14-23, 1980 to acquire samples for his radiochemical measurements and our decontamination studies. Assuming that the samples are shipped expediously to PNL, we estimate laboratory D&D studies will start no earlier than early September, 1980.

 Procedures for decontaminating soils were examined in June. Concrete decontamination procedures will be tested in July on samples from the Hanford F Reactor.
