Gentlemen/Madam:

Pursuant to 10CFR110-5 we hereby apply for a license to export to the Fukushima II Unit No. 2 Power Reactor of The Tokyo Electric Power Company the special nuclear material: enriched uranium dioxide powder as described on the attached Form NRC-7 dated July 11, 1980.


As shown on the Form NRC-7, the material is firstly to be destined to Japan Nuclear Fuel Company for fabrication into fuel assemblies. The UF₆-UO₂ conversion is scheduled to be made by General Electric Company in the U.S. before exportation.

The material is to be owned at the time of delivery at DOE diffusion plant by The Tokyo Electric Power Company and to be used for their initial core fuels of the above referenced reactor.
