This refers to the special inspection conducted by Mr. J. Nicolosi of this office on June 16, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC License No. STC-1031 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Nicolosi with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the item of noncompliance brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letter dated March 22, 1976. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

Our inspector also verified that the scope of your activities are limited to those mentioned in Section 40.13(c)(8) of 10 CFR Part 40. This information will be forwarded to the Material Licensing Branch for appropriate action.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.
