Subject: One-Man Radiography Crews

This refers to your letter dated June 16, 1980 expressing your concern about the use of one-man field radiography crews.

Current NRC regulations permit the employment of one-man field radiography crews provided that the requirements for surveillance, surveys, security, etc., are met. It is our experience that there are some situations that require only one radiographer and others that require two or more radiographers to achieve this goal.
