In the House of Representatives, March 18, 1980

1 WHEREAS, The House Select Committee - TMI found that the
2 decontamination and clean-up at TMI will continue over a period
3 of several years during which time the potential exists for
4 future radiological accidents; and

5 WHEREAS, The committee also found that the dissemination of
6 clear and concise information to appropriate State agencies for
7 action after an accident is necessary to safeguard the health of
8 the citizens of the Commonwealth and that such action could be
9 provided by trained State personnel at each nuclear plant site;
10 therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
12 Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources, through the
13 Bureau of Radiation Protection to establish a Division of
14 Nuclear Plant Inspectors to provide continuous operation and
15 safety inspection capabilities at all nuclear power plants in
16 the Commonwealth; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the Nuclear
2 Regulatory Commission to make the presence of such State
3 inspectors a condition of operating the facility; and be it
4 further

5 RESOLVED, THAT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES REQUESTS THE
6 SECRETARY OF THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
7 RESOURCES AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION
8 TO INDICATE TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SELECT COMMITTEE ON THREE
9 MILE ISLAND, IN WRITING WITHIN 30 DAYS FOLLOWING RECEIPT OF A
10 COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION, THE STATUS OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS SET
11 FORTH HEREIN; AND BE IT FURTHER

12 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
13 the Secretary of Environmental Resources and the Chairman of the
14 Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
