As Ms. Robinson informed you, the nonproprietary version of the technical proposal (48 pages) and the contract and three modifications thereto, in their entirety (approximately 100-150 pages) have already been made available for public inspection and copying at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555.

You may obtain access to these documents by presenting a copy of this letter at the PDR or by requesting the NRC-04-79-209 contract and modifications thereto and folder FOIA-79-455 under the name of Diane Findley. The charge for reproducing records located in the PDR is eight cents (\$0.08) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a). Copies of these documents can be purchased by writing directly to the PDR. With regard to your inquiry as to whether you may request these records from the PDR by telephone, this is to advise that PDR researchers will respond to telephone requests for up to and including four items, depending upon whether a reasonable amount of effort is required to respond to the telephone request. Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Potomac Research, Inc., a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by Potomac Research, Inc., for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage.
