With respect to License No. SUC-1308, the inspection was limited to discussions of your plans for future activities authorized by this license. From these discussions it is our understanding that this license is presently inactive and that you have not received any material authorized by this license. We also understand that you do not plan any use in the near future. We also understand that if you plan to expand the scope of your licensed activities that you will evaluate the need for a full time health physicist. If these understandings are incorrect, please inform us.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
