Subject: Process Control Program

(McGuire Nuclear Station, Units 1 & 2)

By letter dated July 8, 1980, you provided a proprietary report "Process Control Program for CNSI Moble Solidification Units Using the Dow Process" (SD-OP-005). We have reviewed the material based on the requirements and criteria of 10 CFR 2.790 and have determined that the document sought to be withheld contains trade secrets or confidential or privileged commercial or financial information.

In order for us to complete our review and evaluation we request that you provide a non-proprietary PCP considering the non-proprietary Dow report DNS-RSS-001-NP and the non-proprietary CNSI information in order that we can accept the PCP for review. We will need the revised non-proprietary PCP for solidification and the packaging of wet solid radioactive waste by August 15, 1980, in order to evaluate and complete our review before licensing.
