SUMMARY OF JUNE 24, 1980 MEETING

On June 24, 1980, we met with the applicant to discuss his approach to the Task Action Plan (NUREG-0660). The list of attendees is provided as Enclosure (1) and the agenda is listed in Enclosure (2). The viewgraphs used by the applicant are available from the project manager.

The meeting consisted of an explanation by Mississippi Power & Light Company of how it intends to meet all of the requirements of NUREG-0660 and a short presentation on its plan of attack for ATWS. Mr. James P. McGaughy, Jr., Assistant Vice President for Nuclear Production, emphasized the company's commitment to completing the plant on schedule (August 31, 1981) and his desire to resolve all outstanding safety issues as soon as possible. He expressed MP&L's appreciation for the opportunity to present their views and hoped that another meeting could be set up in the near future with the plant's technical reviewers to discuss open issues.
