This is in regard to your petition dated March 10, 1980 on behalf of the Foster Wheeler Energy Corporation.

The petition requests that the Commission exempt persons licensed under 10 CFR Part 34 who deliver licensed material to a carrier for transport under the general license provision of 10 CFR 71.12 from maintaining documentation other than the Certificate of Compliance for a given source material shipping container.

The petition states that the documents, other than the Certificate of Compliance, covered by 10 CFR 71.12(b)(1)(i) are drawings, applications. Test results, photographs, and other correspondence related to the source shipping containers. The pitition further states that these documents are neither helpful nor necessary for persons licensed under 10 CFR Part 34 who deliver packages to carriers under the general license provision of 10 CFR 71.12. Finally, the petition requests that "the regulation, as it pertains to our license category...be withdrawn."

Your petition has been docketed pursuant to 10 CFR 2.802 to recognize your request for amendment of the Commission's regulations. The petition has been assigned Docket Number PRI-71-8. A notice of the petition and request for comments will be published in the Federal Register.

As staff review progresses on your petition, it may be necessary to request additional information. Please reference the assigned docket number on any correspondence you may have concerning the petition. Upon expiration of the comment period we shall furnish you with copies of any comments which have been received in response to the notice of filing of petition for rulemaking.
