I am requesting the following information under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552.

The name of Albert Carnesale has been submitted by President Carter for confirmation to the position of Chairman of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The request is for all materials authored or co-authored by Albert Carnesale regarding the production of energy from nuclear fission, fission or breeder technology.


The request further specifically requests materials written by or supervised by Albert Carnesale during the proceedings of the Generic Environmental Impact Statement on Mixed Oxide Fuels (GEISMO).

I further request any statements obtained by the NRC or the White House regarding Mr. Carnesale's qualifications from members of the public, the scientific community, the Congress, the leadership of industry and labor and others who may in any way impact upon the understanding of the reasons this man was named to this position.

Finally, I request the official statements of Mr. Carnesale to the International Fuel Cycle Evaluation Conference, and any official transcript which may have been available from that conference.

The material requested should be available under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, and due to the immediate nature of the confirmation hearings, the receipt of these materials as soon as is possible would fulfill the stated purposes of this Act as it pertains to public information.
