Request for Transfer of Control of Radioactive Materials License Number 50-27789-01

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to inform you that on August 26, 2019, Hilcorp Alaska LLC entered into a purchase and sale agreement to acquire BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. Closing is anticipated to occur in the second half of 2020. As a result, we are respectfully requesting a transfer of control for Radioactive Materials License Number 50-27789-01 and write to provide the "Information Needed for Transfer of Control" identified in NUREG-1556 Vol. 15, Rev. 1, Appendix E for your review.

Item 1

Describe any planned changes in the organization, including but not limited to, transfer of stocks or assets and mergers, change in members on Board of Directors, etc. Provide the new licensee name, mailing address, and contact information, including phone numbers. Clearly identify when the amendment is due to a name change only.

Response:

Pursuant to the above-referenced purchase and sale agreement, Hilcorp Alaska, LLC will acquire BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. in a stock purchase transaction. After the closing of the transaction, the legal entity BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. will continue to operate as a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hilcorp Alaska, LLC, subject to a name change to "Hilcorp North Slope".

Item 2

Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and any changes in the training program.

Response:

The duties of the Radiation Safety Officer will be performed by Sarra Ghiassi. Licensed materials will continue to be used by, or under the supervision of Transferee.

Item 3

Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

Response:

There will be no changes to the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program as a result of this acquisition.

Item 4

Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

Response:

The acquisition of BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. will result in no changes to the current status of the radiation safety program. The facility will continue to operate as it did prior to the acquisition. The most recent radiation safety program audit conducted on October 28, 2019 was performed in compliance with NUREG 1556, Volume 4, Appendix H for fixed gauges at one of our facilities.

Item 5

If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting those changes.

Response:

Not applicable. No decommissioning funding plan is required under Radioactive Materials License Number 50-27789-01 or applicable regulations.

Item 6

Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

Response:

Not applicable. The facility is not subject to decommissioning. All regulatory records will continue to remain onsite.

Item 7

Confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.

Response:

Both the transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and to the conditions of the transfer. There are no open inspection items and possible enforcement actions to the current Radioactive Materials License Number 50-27789-01.

Item 8

Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

Response:

Hilcorp Alaska, LLC hereby agrees to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor as described in the current Radioactive Materials License Number 50-27789-01.

Item 9

The transferee, in the case of fuel cycle facilities, shall provide documentation showing that it is financial qualified to conduct normal operations. The information can be in the form of income statements and balance sheet forecasts.

Response:

Not applicable. The facilities where the radioactive source materials are used are not fuel cycle facilities.
