Dear Mr. Frazier:

By way of keeping NIOSH informed of clean-up plans and activities at TMI, I have enclosed a copy of a letter on the subject to Senator Hart. In addition, enclosed for your information is a document on the Health Physics Program at TMI.

We are establishing lines of communication to get access to other pertinent decontamination documents and information on meetings to which you will be invited. As I understand it, at the present time, most meetings on decontamination are being held on an ad hoc basis on site. We will apprise you of significant activities as they are planned or carried out.

We are still awaiting NIOSH recommendations on the worker registry and dose data. Would it be possible for you to give us an idea when they might be transmitted? If there are significant changes or actions recommended on the part of the Licensee or NRC, we would like to consider their timely implementation.

I trust that the enclosed information is useful to NIOSH.
