
Dear Mr. Chairman:

As I am sure you know, an impressive delegation from Midland, Michigan, was in Washington last week, seeking to call attention to the desirability -- from an economic point of view -- of an early decision on the construction of a nuclear power facility at Dew.

When I met with the group, I agreed to convey to you my own conclusion that the construction of such a facility would indeed result in substantial benefit in terms of employment and business activity in our area.
