In accordance with the understandings which were reflected by Secretary Udall's letter of March 29, 1968, to Chairman Seaborg, I am forwarding Volumes I and II of the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report submitted by Consumers Power Company. The report contains technical information on two pressurized water nuclear reactors which the Company proposes to construct.

The proposed reactors, designated as the Midland Plant Units 1 and 2, are to be located at the applicant's site on the south shore of the Kalamazoo River, south of the city of Midland in Midland County, Michigan.

Although Consumers Power Company has not yet submitted the administrative portion of its application, which contains the formal request for a facility license for authorization to construct and operate the proposed nuclear power plants, we are beginning the technical portion of our review at this time. Therefore, we would appreciate receiving the results of a review by the Geological Survey of those hydrological features

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of the proposed reactor location which may have a bearing upon our evaluation of the suitability of the proposed site.
