




testimony, filed on December 30, 1976; in continued production of documents for discovery; and in preparation of Licensee's Motion and Brief on the issues to be addressed by this Board, which will be filed shortly; as well as in meeting professional obligations not connected with this case.

3. Licensee and its counsel have attempted to respond as fully as possible within the time available to those interrogatories as to which Licensee has no objections. It was simply unable to complete all of its responses by January 10, 1977. Moreover, due to an unusual delay in the mails, verification of the responses by Mr. Howell could not be provided until January 12, 1977.

4. Licensee is serving its responses on counsel for Intervenors by messenger on January 12. It will serve the responses on the Board and Staff counsel in Washington by messenger on January 13. Consequently, the parties will not be prejudiced by the two day delay in responding, since messenger delivery will obviate delays in the mails.

For all of the foregoing reasons, Licensee requests the Board to grant its motion for leave to file on January 12, 1977.


