NRC STAFF ANSWER TO CONSUMERS' OBJECTIONS AND MOTION REGARDING PROPOSED TRANSCRIPT CORRECTIONS

Consumers Power Company (Consumers) filed on July 27, 1977, its Objections to and Motion to Strike Proposed Transcript Corrections of the Dow Chemical Company.

In that filing, Consumers objects to transcript corrections which Dow served on the parties to this proceeding on January 24, 1977 and March 1, 1977. With regard to each set of proposed transcript corrections, it was incumbent upon the parties to this proceeding to examine them and raise an objection in timely fashion. The NRC Staff, in each case, examined the proposed corrections and raised no objections. If Consumers had objections, they should have been raised far earlier in the proceeding - not five months or more after service. Indeed, on Tuesday, May 13, 1977, Dow moved for an order

amending the transcript in accordance with the March 1, 1977 proposed corrections. No objection was raised by Consumers (Tr. 6279-80).

Consumers' inordinate delay in filing objections constitutes a waiver of its right to object to the proposed corrections and the motion to strike should be denied.
