This is in response to your letter of July 7, 1980, to Mr. John T. Collins, in which you requested technical discussion meetings between your staff and those developing the Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS) prior to its publication. Unfortunately, it is not possible for such a meeting to occur prior to issuance of the statement.

As you recall, the NRC staff met with representatives of Metropolitan Edison and its contractors several times in the past regarding information for the statement. The most recent meeting was with Messrs. Earl Showalter and L. J. Lehman on June 30, 1980. This meeting was very helpful and provided us with the latest technical information on radioactive wastes for inclusion in the document.
