

Perhaps you are aware that CMP is planning an experimental high-level nuclear waste storage scheme in Wiscasset, and final hearings are to take place on their proposal immediately after the Nuclear Referendum in Sept. If you are not up on this matter, here is a brief rundown: The spent fuel pool at Maine Yankeo was originally designed to hold a maximum of 159 metric tons of heavy metal (spent fuel). They have now suggested storing up to 772 metric tons (5 times as much as original specs.) in that same pool. To do this, they plan to use an experimental means of compacting the rods. Each fuel assembly (a fuel rod assembly weighs about & metric ton) will be dismantled by remote control, and each rod will be placed in new assemblies, in a tighter formation. To quote CMP's 1979 10-K report: "The modification of this capacity proposed by the Company differs from designs heretofore implemented at other nuclear facilities but is essentially the same basic compapt of more compact storage in the existing spent fuel pool."

I don't think Maine should be designated a proving ground for high-level nuclear experiments by the nuclear industry, and I am appealing to you for help on this matter.

I have many reasons to believe the NRC is an ally of Waine Youkee first and a protector of the public safety second. The NGC will be making the decision on this matter. I urge you to look into the matter for the sake of all of your constituents.
