Dear Sir/Madam:

On behalf of Kernkraftwerk Kaiseraugst, we hereby wish to amend U.S.N.R.C. Export license XUO8427.

Kaiseraugst has a contract with General Electric which covers the fabrication of the first core and two reloads plus an option to fabricate the third and fourth reloads.

As the Kaiseraugst reactor is scheduled for operation in late 1983, we would like to add possible storage in Switzerland prior to European enrichment as well as increasing the quantity by 179,500 kgs. uranium as natural UF6.

Please extend the expiration date of the amended export license to 1990 which should eliminate the need for multiple redundant retransfers for approvals in the event that interagency procedures will allow licensed actions to proceed for the life of the export license. We realize that the license expiration date will be annually subject to the extension of the Euratom/USA Bilateral Agreement for Cooperation.

We look forward to receiving this amendment on a timely basis.
