Subject: Supplement No. 11 to the Safety Evaluation Report - North Anna

Power Station, Unit 2

Twenty copies of Supplement No. 11 to the Safety Evaluation Report for the North Anna Power Station, Unit 2 are enclosed for your use. This report was issued by the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation in connection with your application for an operating license for the North Anna Power Station, Unit 2. This report pertains only to Unit 2 and addresses the staff's evaluation and status of the Non-TMI-2 outstanding issues identified in Supplement No. 10, the TMI-2 requirements which must be completed prior to issuance of a full power operating license, and the dated requirements which the licensee must implement by the dates identified in NUREG-0694, "TMI-Related Requirements for New Operating Licenses."
