Packaging Of Low-Level Radioactive Waste for Transport and Burial

In Response:

Isotopic Analysis, Inc. does maintain a current set of NRC and DOE regulations concerning the transfer, packaging, and transport of low-level radioactive waste.

Isotopic Analysis, Inc. does maintain a current set of requirements (license) placed on Nuclear Engineering Company, Inc. by the State of Washington.

Implementation of all other items included in IE Bulletin No. 79-19 will be completed by October 10, 1979.

Isotopic Analysis, Inc. made one (1) low-level radioactive waste shipment between January 1, 1978 and June 30, 1979. The volume of that shipment was 67.5 cubic feet of laboratory waste (paper, plastic, glass, etc.). The shipment contained less than four (4) millicuries of primarily Uranium 235 isotope. This shipment contained approximately two (2) kilograms of liquid or soluble waste on 2X absorbent (dessicated clay).
