Dear Mr. Peterson:

General Atomic Company (GAC) is engaged in the manufacture and sale of nuclear reactors, nuclear instrumentation systems, components therefor, and cooperative research in the development and testing of the components and fuels for research reactors. In the normal servicing of our research reactors we are required to provide replacement equipment and materials. In this case, General Atomic will be providing specifically designed parts and components for research reactors for four sites in Germany. Munich is the major purchaser of such parts and components. However, the other German sites may also have need for replacements, etc., so we have included them in this application.

The license should include nuclear reactor specifically designed parts and components as in 10 CFR 110 Appendix A (a)(2)(3)(8) (9) and Appendix A(a)(10) parts and components for the sub-categories above. Included also are fission chambers.
