Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 40, Source Material License No. SUA-1358 is hereby amended by revising Conditions 28 and 29 to read as follows:

- 28. By September 1, 1980, the licensee shall submit to the Uranium Recovery Licensing Branch documentation showing that the current owner and any subsequent owner of any subsurface rights to land to be used for tailings disposal will be made aware that such land is being used for disposal of radioactive material and will be subject to a NRC license prohibiting the disruption and disturbance of the tailings. Documentation shall, as a minimum, consist of notification of the above in local public land records.
- 29. Surety arrangements required by this license shall be satisfied for the first year by Letter of Credit No. PM 3050-03 issued by the Republic National Bank of Dallas with the NRC as beneficiary. At least three months prior to the expiration date (May 16, 1981) of this Letter of Credit or of any subsequent sureties or prior to any revision to existing surety arrangements, the licensee shall submit a copy of the proposed new surety or revision and supporting documentation, showing a breakdown of the associated reclamation and decommissioning costs, to the Uranium Recovery Licensing Branch for review and approval. The licensee is required to receive approval of any new surety or revision to an existing surety prior to depositing tailings into any cell which is not included in the reclamation covered by an existing surety.

The NRC will not terminate the license until final stabilization and reclamation of the tailings disposal area and decommissioning and decontamination of the mill site and open lands meets the requirements of Condition No. 27.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

The above conditions were discussed in a July 7, 1980 telephone conversation between your Mr. George Glasier and Mr. D. Gillen of my staff.
