Item 25 Additional Information (continued)

The early requirement of March, 1981 for this license is based on our understanding that the customer's bid requirement will state that if the fuel license, plant equipment license (applied for 4/23/80 as Amendment to XR-113) and all other licenses required are not available by March 1981, the bidder will be considered disqualified.

Surely this new and unique requirement can only be an expression of the customer's deep concern regarding security and timeliness-of-supply when dealing with U.S. suppliers. This represents the first time Taipower has gone out additionally for non-U.S. bids; to France and to the Federal Republic of Germany. We anticipate the French and Germans will have no problem in meeting this requirement. Therefore, in order to confirm the U.S. as a reliable supplier - a clear objective of the NNPA - and thereby prevent us from being disqualified as a bidder for this major project, we ask that every effort be made to grant this license before March 1981. Towards this objective, we propose that the "no material changed circumstance" provision of the NNPA be exercised. Consistent with the criterion of the NNPA, we believe that there is no material changed circumstance associated with this new application from those existing at the time of the last Commission approved application; XR-113 issued June 8, 1979.
