Dear Sirs:

We hereby present you a bill and claims for damages caused by the effects of nuclear radiation and gas releases from the nuclear plants at Three Mile Island in the Susquehanna River near Middletown Pa. Being that you knew in advance that such radiations and very poisonous radio-active gas releases would occur and have occurred and would cause physical damage to all life for many miles around and kill all life, and have kept it secret and have told us and the public that all was safe, clean and cheap and that there was nothing to worry about, we have been assured by you into a false sense of security. You have told us that there never was an accident when indeed there have been many and there are many.

you said there would not be and was no radiation, when in fact there was high radiation. You said there would be no physical damage or harm when in fact there were many cases of fatal physical damages due to the operation of the nuclear reactors. All of these actions on your part constitutes deliberate, willful negligence and since you have resorted to believing us that the nuclear operations were safe when indeed they were harmful also constitutes criminal negligence.

Therefore as a result of all that, we lost 160 Holsteins since the nuclear operations began on Three Mile Island due to the nuclear effects upon them. In addition we have lost many other animals such as dogs, cats, poultry, geese, ducks and crops. Also our health has been injured due to the likewise and physical torment caused by the nuclear related damages here.

We demand payment for these damages as thus here mentioned:

160 Holsteins that died — \$160,000  
43 Holsteins that were ~~were~~  
made sterile due to the  
nuclear effects — \$213,000

Loss of Milk production over  
the years since 1969 that nuclear  
activity took place on Three Mile  
Island ————— \$ 110,000

Loss of crops ————— \$ 55,000

Damages to our physical health  
due to the torment, worry, frustrations  
etc due to the nuclear effects  
at \$100,000 for each one of us ————— \$ 400,000

Loss of leg (due to nuclear effects)  
of Annice A. Holowka ————— \$ 1,000,000

Loss of dogs:  
loss of pups over  
the years since 1969 ————— \$ 66,000  
Loss of dogs due to  
cancers, leukemia, and injuries  
cause by nuclear effects. ————— \$ 18,000

Total — \$ 1,852,000

This is what you owe us and we  
demand full payment or settlement on this.  
We have been ~~totally~~ totally financially

ruined due to nuclear radiation and its  
effects of the Three Mile Island operations  
owned and operated by ~~General~~ General  
Public Utilities Corporation and Metro-  
politan Edison Power and Light Co.
