SUBJECT: SECY-A-80-43 - DIRECTOR'S DENIAL OF 2.206 RELIEF (IN THE MATTER OF DAIRYLAND POWER COOPERATIVE) (COMMISSIONER ACTION ITEM)

This is to advise you that four Commissioners have agreed that there is no need for a review of this decision of the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. Commissioner Gilinsky did not participate in this action.

In connection with his concurrence in no review, Commissioner Bradford provided the following comment: "I am not comfortable with the decision on Appendix J failures, but I don't believe that that issue warrants further attention in the context of this reactor since it is apparently to be decommissioned."
