Dear Mr. Bauer:

By your letters dated January 2 and June 4, 1980, you provided information on the high range effluent noble gas monitors installed at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station.

We have reviewed your submittal and determined that your description of the presently installed system satisfies our requirements for range, scale overlap, power source and display. We also reviewed schematics of the location of the monitors in the off-gas stack monitoring system and the vent monitoring systems and conclude that the arrangements are acceptable.

In view of the above, we conclude that you have satisfied our requirements for high range effluent monitors related to Item 2.1.8.b of our TMI-2 Short Term Lessons Learned requirements and Item III.D.2.1 of the TMI Action Plan (NUREG-0660).

We expect that we will require Technical Specifications for these detectors. This matter will be addressed in future correspondence.
