In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 50.59, we are enclosing 40 copies of a requested amendment to license DPR-52 to change the technical specifications of the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant unit 2 (Enclosure 1). The proposed technical specifications reflect new primary containment atmospheric hydrogen monitoring instrumentation be installed during the upcoming unit 2 refueling outage. Also enclosed are 40 copies of the system description and justification for the proposed changes (Enclosure 2).
